Current staff are all working hard to maintain library services with the least amount of disruption to the public.

This year's theme for **Summer Reading** is "All Together Now". Our 6 week program at Main will be on Friday and on Monday in Hermansville at the Sportsman's Club. A monthly **Lego Club** has started here at Main meeting on the last Tuesday of the month, all are welcome. There will be a **RAN** event (Reading Adventure for families) in partnership with the Menominee County Literacy Coalition at the Main Library on February 28. We have ordered more books to stock **Book Oasis** program. This program was funded in part by a Grant from Dollar General. **Basics to Browsing** our digital literacy program, continues to be well received both for classes and the on-on-one instruction. Sessions have been offered at the Main Library and at both Meyer and Gourley Township halls.

The Friends are making plans and recruiting vendors for **Library in Bloom** (June 3<sup>rd</sup>). As a reminder so if you are starting plants please consider adding a few extra for the Library. The **Holiday Fest** is scheduled for the Stephenson School November 4<sup>th</sup>.
