


LIBRARY NEWS

Joan Brown, deeply appreciated library supporter, passed away recently. She and her husband, Don, moved a few years ago to the Beloit, Wisconsin area, but her memory is strong in the minds and hearts of the library staff, Friends, and patrons.

Joan was a member of the Superiorland Library Cooperative Board for over 20 years. That Board administers funds from the state and pass-through money from library members, covering the Upper Peninsula and some northern Michigan counties.



She also served on the Menominee County Library Board for several years, moving on to the presidency of the Friends of Menominee County Library. She retired from library work with years as one of the Friends' board of directors. Joan's approach to the presidency of the Friends' volunteer organization was in highly active terms in which she initiated, worked to develop, and guided to conclusion book sales, book readings, plant sales, summer story time weeks, and annual fund-raising dinners. One of her fondest activities tied into her love of quilting, as she and other members supplied a yearly quilt to use as a raffle prize.
